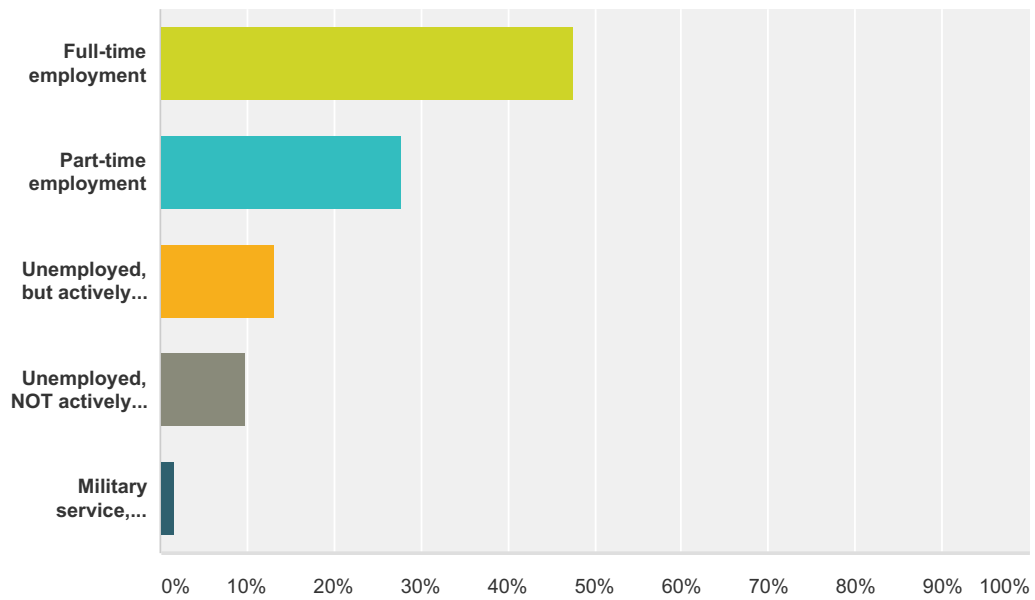


Q1 What is your present employment status?

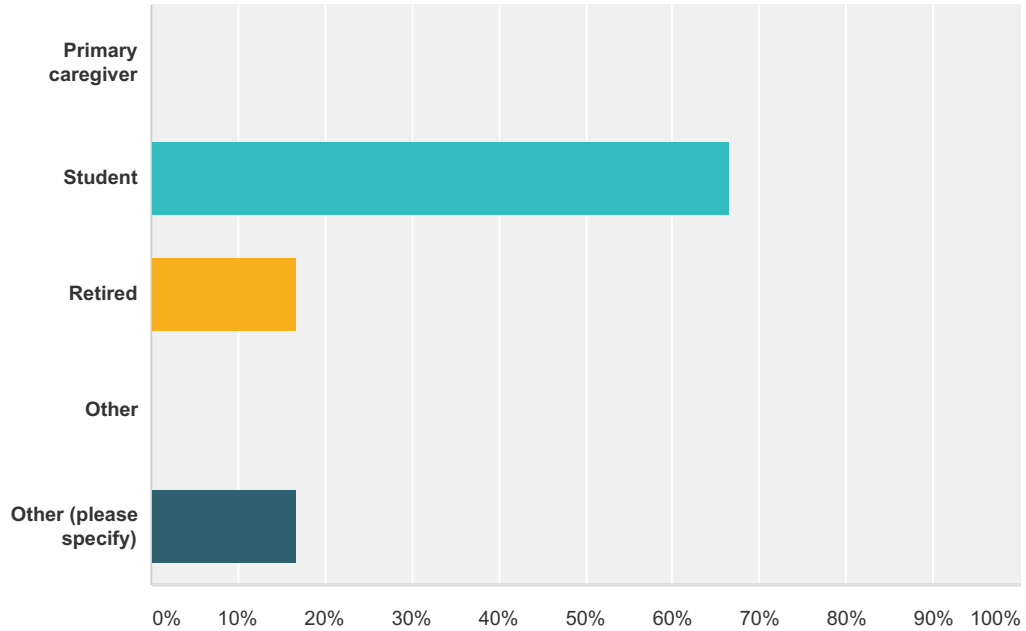

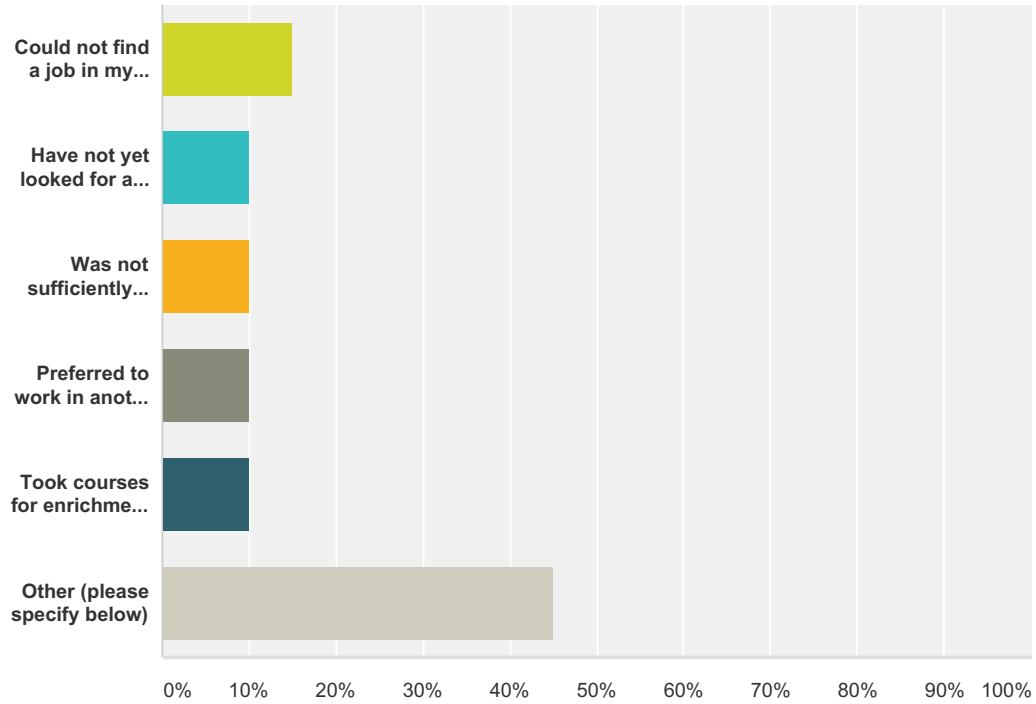

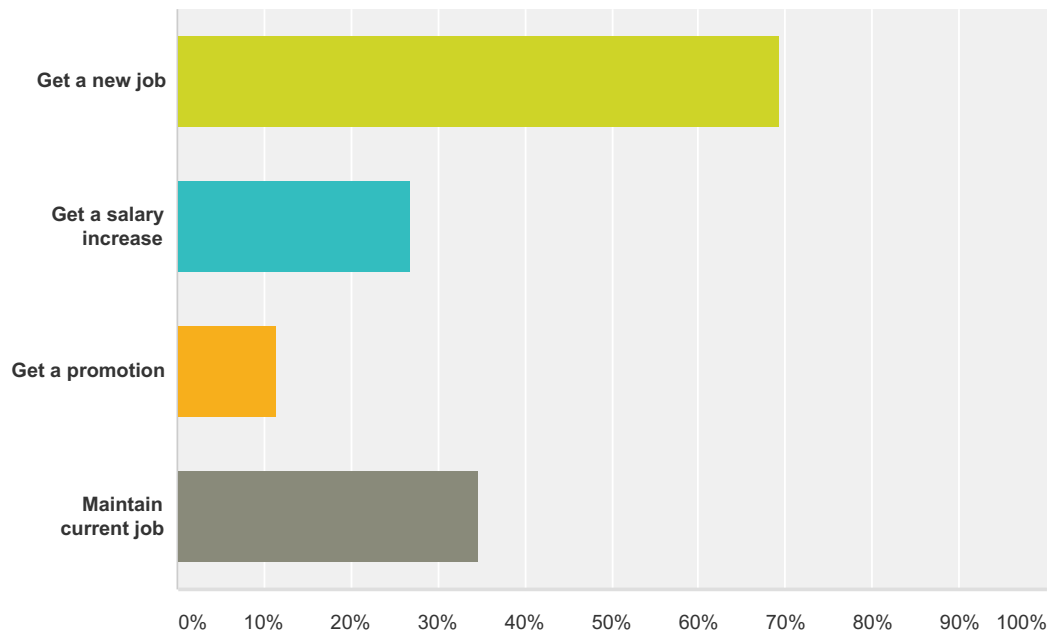

Q9 Did your community college education help you... (check all that apply)

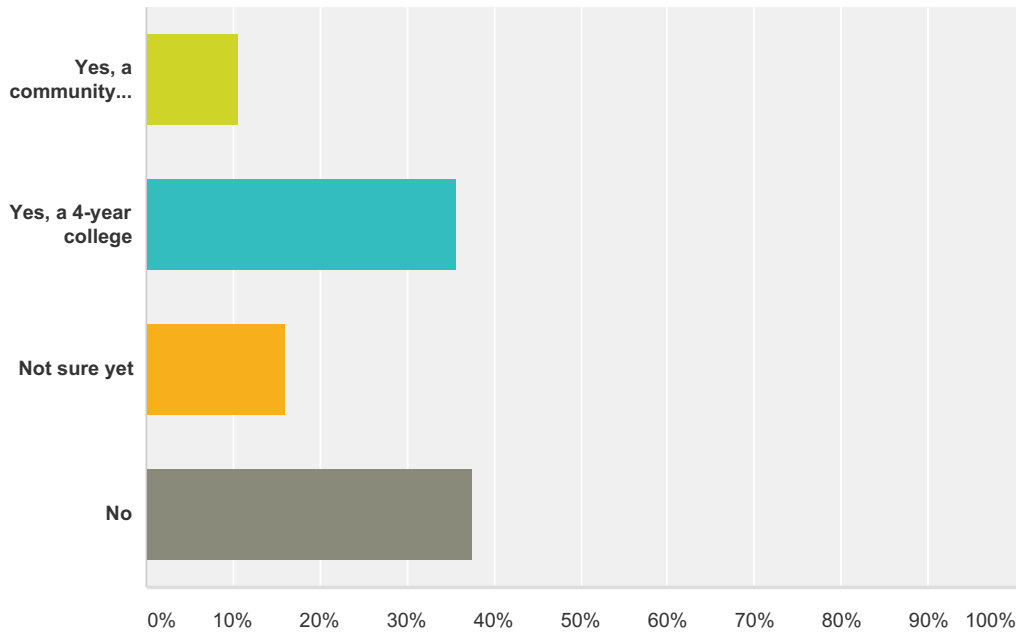

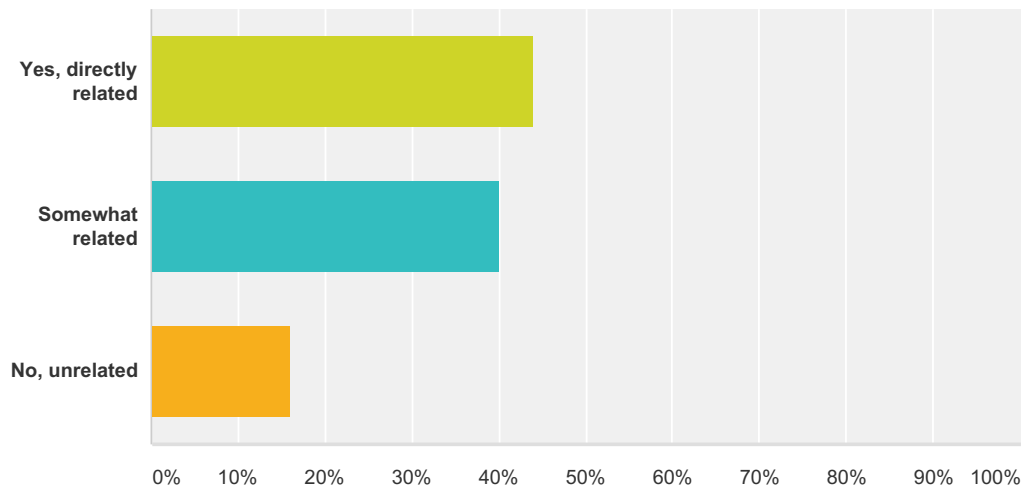

Q12 Will your academic major this fall be related to your community college major?

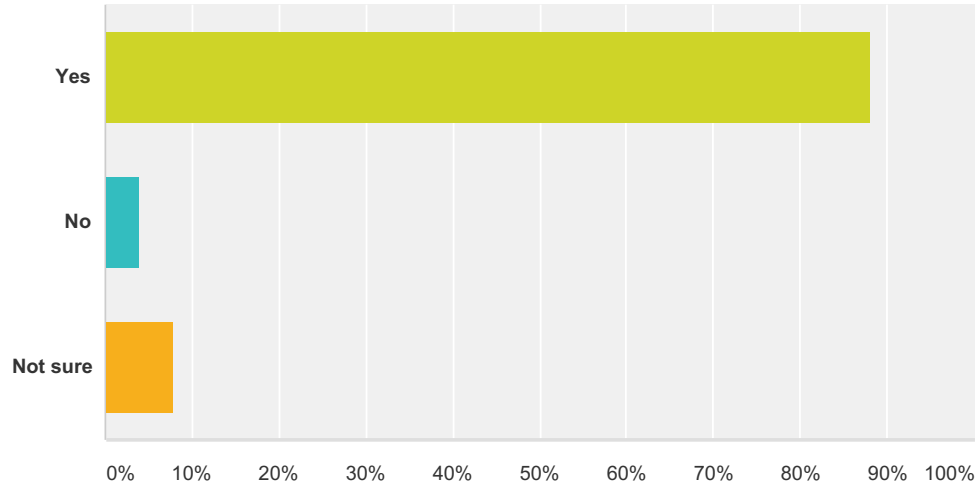

Q13 Do you feel your current community college education has prepared you for your future college studies?

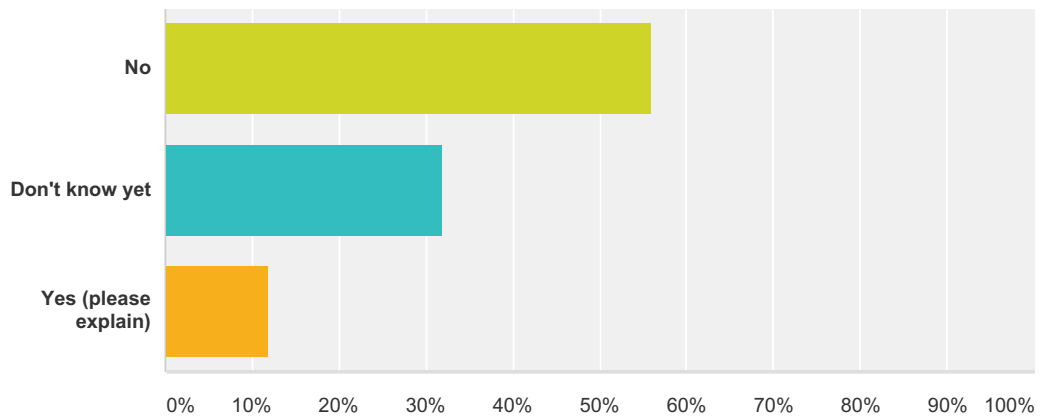
