To be considered a Transfer Sophomore Nursing applicant, the following classes would need to be successfully completed (defined as a C+ or better) within the last 5 years (10 years if you have an associate's or bachelor's degree):

- A&P 1 = BIO 211
- A&P 2 = BIO 212
- Intro to Sociology = SOC 101
- Intro to Psychology = PSY 111
- Microbiology = BIO 235
- English 101 = ENG 101
- English 102 = ENG 102
- Developmental Psychology = PSY 201
- Chemistry = CHE 111 (this is a prerequisite for ACC's Gen, Org, & Bio Chemistry)

Admission & Application Information

- AIC also accepts "Freshman level transfer nursing students" - students who have done some, but not all, of the above mentioned courses.
- The minimum GPA requirement is a 2.5, but generally our accepted students have well above the minimum requirement.
- AIC does not offer evening or accelerated programs for nursing at this time, nor bridge programs.
- To apply, students can simply go to www.aic.edu and click "apply".
- Application requirements include the online application, copy of high school diploma or GED, and official college transcript(s). If you do apply, use the fee waiver code *Admissions9*. Please note the application deadline for Nursing for Fall is March 15th.
- Transfer Nursing Information Sessions are offered every Friday at 10am and 1pm at American International College.
