Computer Science/Cybersecurity Instructor Full-Time (35 hours/week), 10 Month, Tenure Track

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Master's Degree in Cybersecurity, Information Systems, Computer Science, Information Assurance, or related field required. Three years' teaching in higher education. Ability to teach a variety of cybersecurity and information technology courses at both Asnuntuck Community College and Tunxis Community College. Industry experience of 3-5 years. Knowledge of learning outcomes assessment. Familiarity with trends occurring in the Computer Science and Cybersecurity fields. Relevant industry certifications needed such as CISSP, GIAC, and/ or CISM preferred. Demonstrate commitment to the community college mission and its diverse student population. Evidence of strong verbal and written communication and interpersonal skills.

Applicants who do not meet the minimum qualifications as stated are encouraged to put in writing precisely how their background and experience have prepared them for the responsibilities of this position and by providing appropriate references.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS: Experience teaching at a community college. Ability to use technology, experience teaching online or hybrid courses, and use of learning management systems. Evidence of reflective teaching practice. Ability to address the needs of a diverse student body with an array of learning styles. Potential for long-term growth both as a teacher and as a creative and collaborative colleague.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Teach 30 credit hours of Cybersecurity and Computer Science. These courses will require participation as faculty member at Asnuntuck Community College while including a split teaching assignment at Asnuntuck Community College and Tunxis Community College. Release time will be given during year one to develop a Cybersecurity program for both Tunxis and Asnuntuck Community College. Related responsibilities include curriculum review and development, professional development, student advising, assessment, community outreach, K-12 collaboration, and NECHE reviews and assessment. Participate in discipline, department, college, and system meetings and committees. Teaching responsibilities may include evening or online courses. May be required to teach a First Year Experience or College and Career Success Course. Perform additional responsibilities in accordance with an approved plan. Coordinate the testing facility associated with the Cybersecurity certifications. May be required to attend Cybersecurity related conferences.

MINIMUM SALARY: \$55,571 approximate annual, plus excellent benefits package.
