Asnuntuck Community College and the University of Connecticut have a transfer agreement in the field of Psychology. Students at ACC can take a course of study within the Liberal Arts Degree and transfer to UConn as Juniors in the Psychology major. This transfer agreement is part of the Guaranteed Admissions Agreement with UConn.

Students must earn a grade of C or better; courses must be completed within seven years prior to transfer to UConn. Other courses may be used for credit toward graduation pending approval by UConn.

Each one of the 12 Connecticut Community Colleges has specific graduation requirements that must be met at that campus. This document is a general understanding of a Transfer Plan of Study between the Community College System and the University of Connecticut Psychology Department.
