### Program Information

**Program Outcomes:** The Accounting program covers topics in financial, managerial, intermediate and cost accounting in addition to a variety of foundational courses. Upon completion of the program, graduates are able to: Demonstrate an ability to communicate verbally and in writing; prepare financial statements; demonstrate critical thinking and problem solving skills; use information technology to prepare financial reports;

**Transfer Opportunities:** Students transfer successfully to the Connecticut State Universities and are able to utilize transfer equivalencies and advising resources. The transfer counselor can always be consulted when transferring.

**Employment Information:** Students with an accounting degree are employable in many fields: retail, manufacturing, banking, insurance and many others. Graduates find jobs in the public, private and not-for-profit sectors.

**Graduation Information:** A cumulative 2.0 GPA is required to graduate. All courses for degree credit must be numbered 100 or above. Students must complete and submit a Graduation Application to the Registrar's Office in order to graduate. *Graduation Application deadlines* : December graduation - December 1st, May graduation - March 31st, August graduation - August 1st.
